

**Def**inition of *shame* (Dictionary.com):

- 1. the painful feeling arising from the consciousness of something dishonorable, improper, ridiculous, done by oneself or another: She was overcome with shame.
- **2.** a fact or circumstance bringing disgrace or regret: The bankruptcy of the business was a shame.

**In** Revelation 3:18, it's more of a poisonous shame, a painful emotion that causes deep regret and sorrow.

- 1. Dictionary definition—blind: [adj. \blīnd\]<sup>17</sup>
  - a. <u>unable</u> to see; lacking the sense of sight; sightless.
  - **b.** <u>unwilling</u> or unable to perceive or understand.

2. Medical definition—blindness: [/blind·ness/ (blīnd´nes)]18

Cindy's eye doctor, Dr. Stacy Davis, says,

"Total blindness is the complete lack of form and visual light perception. It is clinically recorded as NLP, an abbreviation for 'no light perception.' Those who cannot perceive light have no sight."

3. Biblical definition—blindness: [/blind·ness/ (blīnd´nes)] <sup>19</sup>		
a. destitute of sight (physically or spiritually).		
Blindness is both a physical and spiritual condition. Blindness is also a spiritual metaphor, used to represent the spiritualinability to see God's Truth


